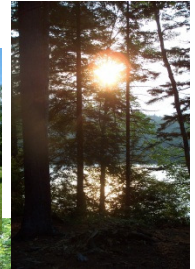


Annual Adopt-A-Cabin

All skill levels are welcome. If you or your group has an expertise in any of the carpentry trades, come and bring your tools.



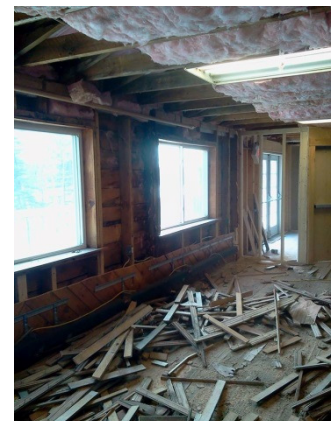
What is the cost?
